

## BOARD MEMBER RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Must be willing to actively serve a full 2-year term.
2. Must know and support the mission, goals, bylaws, and principles of governance of CUDO.
3. Must actively promote CUDO by attending special events, encouraging and supporting other members, enhancing its public image and standing, clearly articulating its mission, accomplishments, and goals to the public, and garnering support from the community.
4. Must come to regularly scheduled Board meetings and board retreats on time, prepared to engage in dialogue and debate, while demonstrating assertive communication skills in both speaking and listening. If missed, it is the personal responsibility of the member to review discussed information in a timely manner in order to stay abreast of current business.
5. Must accept collective responsibility for the decisions of the Board of Directors.
6. Must help organize or co-organize events, and be comfortable approaching people for help. In the future, once committees are established, must actively serve on at least one committee.
7. Must be willing to physically help with tasks such as posterage, screen printing, hanging shows, and setting up events when needed.
8. Must have communication capability with CUDO as some business is conducted outside of the scheduled board meetings. This includes responding to all communication within a timely manner.
9. Must conduct oneself in a respectful and professional manner.
